We are pleased that you are interested in having your district participate in The National Title I Study of Implementation and Outcomes: Early Childhood Language Development (ECLD), sponsored by the Institute of Education Sciences (IES) in the U.S. Department of Education. As we discussed during the phone call on [DATE], the study will be limited to Title I schools that have a prekindergarten, kindergarten, and first through third grades and that meet certain reading proficiency criteria.
