Rights of Research Subjects Fact Sheet

If you choose to be in this research study, you have the right to:

- 1. Be informed about the study and why we are doing it.
- 2. Have the study staff explain all study procedures.
- 3. Be told if there is a chance of any discomfort or risk from the study.
- 4. Have the study staff explain the benefits of participating in the study.
- 5. Ask any questions about the study or procedures.
- 6. Withdraw from the study at anytime without penalty.
- 7. Know where your information will be stored and how it will be shared.
- 8. Choose whether to participate in any part of the study without the use of any force or undue influence on your decision.

Because sensitive information is collected in this study, <<site>> received a Certificate of Confidentiality. This means that any information that <<site>> has that identifies you or your child will be used only for this study. It cannot be given to anyone else unless you give your written consent or unless required by law.
