Adjustments increase above amount to 216 *hours*, while adjustment decreases amount to 72 hours. Overall, adjustments above increased the burden by 144 hours and increased responses by five (5).

Program Changes and Adjustments combined increased the burden by 17,304 hours, and increased the number of responses by 2,138.
