Research Questions to Address:

- Is 1the requested information available in respondent's records?
- 1Do respondents have issues with comprehending the terminology used in the questions?
- How burdensome are the questions?

Expected Length of Interview: 20-30 minutes

Before the Ouestions:

- What was your experience completing this year's MEPS-IC?
- Thank respondent for completing the survey and participating in test questions.

Questions for each item of interest:

- What is this item asking for, in your opinion?
- How would you go about completing this item?
- Do you have access to all the information you need, or would you need to get help from others?
 - (If need help) Who would you contact? Where is s/he located in the company? What is her/his role?
 - How would you communicate the request? How would s/he return the data to you?
 - Would you attempt to validate the response they gave you in any way, for example by comparing it to other data you had?
- What records would you use to answer this question?
- Were there any terms that seemed strange or confusing to you?
 - (If yes) Which ones? How can we clarify that?
- On a scale from 1 to 5, with 1 being very easy and 5 being very difficult, how would you rate the difficulty of this question?
- On a scale from 1 to 5, with 1 being easily accessible and 5 being not at all accessible, how would you rate the accessibility of this question?

Specific Probes for Items of Interest:

Item 1

- A) Were you familiar with the term "individual attachment point"?
- A) Do the breakouts make sense to you?
- B) Were you familiar with the term "aggregate attachment point"?
- B) (If less than 100%) Is that percentage above the 100% of expected claims?
- C) (If categories are not as expected, probe further.)

Item 2

- A) How do you define "smoker status"?
- C) Were you familiar with the term "rehabilitative care"?
- C) Were you familiar with the term "habilitative care"?

Item 3

- A) Were you familiar with the term "actuarial value"?
- A) (If less than 30% or more than 95%, probe further.)

Item 4

- A) Were you familiar with the term "grandfathered health plan"?
- A) Were you familiar with the term "Affordable Care Act"?

Item 5

A) Were you familiar with the term "domestic partners"?

Item 6

- A) Were you familiar with the term "Health Insurance Exchange"?
- B) Were you familiar with the term "Small Business Health Care Tax Credit"?

Wrap Up

- How long do you think it would take you to complete the questions we just discussed (total time, not elapsed time)?
- Are you the best person to answer these questions?
- Overall, on a scale from 1 to 5, with 1 being very easy and 5 being very difficult, how easy or difficult would you say these questions are?
- · Which questions were easier, more difficult?
- Do you have any other suggestions or recommendations for improvement for these questions, or any others on this form?
