In accordance with title 5 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) Act, Part 1320.13, "Emergency Processing," the Department of Defense requests emergency processing and approval of a public information collection requirement. This emergency submission is necessary to allow collection analysis of information related to the repeal of the law known as "Don't Ask Don't Tell" prior to the submission of the report to the Secretary of Defense on December 1, 2010. The Paperwork Reduction Act submission package and the Statement of Determination for emergency processing are at Enclosures (1) and (2) respectively.

The Department of Defense cannot reasonably comply with the normal clearance procedures under title 5, CFR, Part 1320.13. The use of normal procedures under title 5, CFR, Part 1320.13, is likely to delay or disrupt the collection of the information and impact the Department of Defense Comprehensive Review Working Group's ability to fulfill its tasking by the Secretary of Defense to study the impact of repeal of the law and report to him by December 1, 2010. The information collection is essential to the mission of the Department. Given this, the Department is requesting emergency approval by June 11, 2010.
