Dear Mr. Frey:

Under the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) guidelines at 5 CFR 1320.13, we request emergency processing of the enclosed information collection request (ICR) associated with a Notice to Lessees and Operators (NLT). This will be an information collection for lessees and operators in the Outer Continental Shelf (OCS). According to the emergency processing procedures:

(a) We have determined that:

- (1) The collection of this information is needed to begin before the expiration of time periods established under 5 CFR Part 1320 and the information is essential in carrying out the requirements of the Increased Safety Measures for Energy Development on the Outer Continental Shelf report from the Secretary of the Interior to the President. In a memorandum dated June 2, 2010, to the Director, Minerals Management Service (now the Bureau of Ocean Energy Management, Regulation, and Enforcement) Secretary Salazar informed the Director to adopt the recommendations outlined in the report and implement them as soon as possible.
- (2) We cannot comply with normal clearance procedures because an unanticipated event has occurred that could impact safety of operations and prevention of environmental pollution in the OCS.

(b) We request that OMB make a decision on this emergency ICR within 5-10 working days of receiving it.

(c) We have not formally consulted with potential respondents on the impact of this burden due to time constraints. Our estimate of the annual burden hours is based on a few informal conversations with oil and gas industry representatives and our experience with similar documentation requirements and reports submitted.

(d) We are requesting a waiver of the 60-day and 30-day *Federal Register* notices required in 5 CFR 1320.13(d).
