Other change** To amend the approved PISA 2009 incentive plan (1850-0755 v.7) to encourage higher response rates so that the United States can meet international sampling requirements and be included in the reported PISA results, and to improve comparability of incentives and stipends across schools. The proposed changes are consistent with the final incentive plan used for PISA 2006: (1) increase the incentive for refusing schools unable to attend the recent PISA summer conference for participating schools to the average amount spent on schools that attended the conference (\$1500); and (2) increase the stipends for school coordinators (to \$300) and students (to \$75) in schools conducting the assessment out of school hours to better reflect the opportunity cost of their participation.
