
This is to request approval for a survey in connection with strategic planning for the United States International Trade Commission ("the Commission") with respect to the effectiveness of exclusion orders issued by the Commission following investigations under section 337 of the Tariff Act of 1930 (19 U.S.C. §1337). Enclosed are the following items: (1) Form 83-I, (2) supporting statement with attachments, (3) *Federal Register* notice entitled "Agency Form Submitted to OMB for Review," and (4) two survey forms and transmittal letters.

The Commission has decided to use a survey, which will be used only once, to gather important data that is not available from any other sources.
