Re: April 8, 2008 Hearing of the SSFL Special Exposure Cohort Petition

Dear Mr. Elliott:

Per your request this is my appeal to investigate the whole period of my petition from 1955 until the present.

We have an outcry in this community over the scheduling of the April 8 hearing which was heard by the Advisory Board in Tampa, Florida at 5:30 am West Coast time. It was impossible to have my lawmakers, former employees and activists partake of the hearing.

The vote on my petition by the Advisory Board was postponed until SC&A reviews the data. I am requesting that the next hearing on the SSFL petition be heard in either Simi Valley, California or Calabassas, California to give all concerned parties an opportunity to hear and be heard on all matters. It would be a mistake to schedule a hearing in Los Angeles as traffic often prevents entry into the city.

I was alarmed by two things I heard during the hearing. I believe Mr. Hinnefeld stated that no monitoring records meant that person was not a radiation worker. That couldn't be further from the truth. Also I believe it was Dr. Worthington who said that site experts would be brought in to help the workgroup members find reports and data. Our site expert is the expert witness against the workers compensation claims who writes modern day reports distorting the truth. All reports with his name included should be banned as references.

Please notify me as soon as possible about the next Advisory Board meeting which will address the SSFL SEC Peition.
