Once again it is time to collect information about persons under sentence of death in your jurisdiction. Enclosed are NPS-8 and NPS-8A forms for calendar year 2009. The Census Bureau collects these data for the Bureau of Justice Statistics (BJS) under the authority of Title 42, U.S.C. § 3732. We assure you that all data provided for these inmates will be held in strict confidentiality, as provided under Title 42, U.S.C. § 3735 and § 3789g. We estimate that your reporting burden will average 15 minutes per response, including the time needed to review instructions, search existing data sources, gather and maintain the data needed, and complete and review the collection of information.
