
The Department is seeking emergency review of the Paperwork Reduction Act requirements for a new information collection which supports the issuance of \$100 million dollars available through the Sustainable Communities Regional Planning Grant Program that was part of the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2010 (Public Law 111-117, approved December 16, 2009). The Notice of Paperwork Submission (copy enclosed), proposed for immediate *Federal Register* publication, explains the burden of the collection requirements and invites public comments on them.

In compliance with the requirements of 5 CFR 1320.13, this letter requests emergency processing within 7 days from the date of this letter. The collection of this information is necessary due to 5 CFR 1320.13 (1)(i). The Department, HUD, has been charged with the issuance of the Sustainable Communities Regional Planning Grant Program (SCRPG); to issue the funds available under this program, we need to publish the Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA). The SCRPG NOFA has incorporated the proposed data collection form to facilitate the submission of information by the applicant and also to facilitate the review process of applications. Consequently, in order for the Department to issue this NOFA, we need to have approval of this data collection form.

The shortened processing period that we are requesting will help facilitate the prompt issuance of the funds to the public and ensure that we comply with the requirements of the Appropriations Act.
