III. PERSONS ELIGIBLE TO VOTE:
Any person who:  1. is now engaged in Cameron, Hidalgo, or Willacy County, Texas in the production of oranges or grapefruit for market; and  2. was so engaged during the period
<u>INDIVIDUAL OWNER:</u> An individual owner is any producer who has the sole interest in the oranges or grapefruit he/she produces. He/she may cast only one Ballot regardless of the number of groves he/she

operates.
