| <p>Page 5, What Is the Filing Fee? A fee of \$670 must be submitted for filing Form I-600.</p> | <p>Page 5, What Is the Filing Fee? A fee of \$720 must be submitted for filing Form I-600.</p> |
| <p>Page 5, Column 2: An additional biometric fee of \$85 for fingerprinting every adult person living in the household in the United States where the child will reside must also be submitted.</p> | <p>Page 5, Column 2: An additional biometric fee of \$85 for fingerprinting every adult person living in the household where the child will reside must also be submitted. | <p>Page 5, Column 2: NOTE: If the prospective adoptive parents and any other adult members of the household reside abroad at the time of filing, they are exempt from paying the USCIS biometric services fee. However, they may have to pay the fingerprinting fee charged by the U.S. consular office or military installation.</p> | <p>Page 5, Column 2: NOTE- deleted this paragraph.</p> |
