

<p>P. 8 What Is the Filing Fee?</p> <p>There is no filing fee for Form I-918.</p> <p>However, a biometric fee of \$85 is required when filing this Form I-918. After you submit Form I-918, USCIS will notify you about when and where to go for biometric services.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The check or money order must be drawn on a bank or other financial institution located in the United States and must be payable in U.S. currency; and 2.
