Registered Crab Receivers that operate as shoreside processors or stationary floating crab processors and receive and purchase landings of raw CR crab must use this form to complete and submit a CR RCR Ex-vessel Volume and Value Report for the current crab fishing year. The reporting period of the CR RCR Ex-vessel Volume and Value Report extends from August 15 through April 30 of the following year, inclusive. This report must be completed and submitted by May 15th.

- Select a Registered Crab Receiver permit number from the 'RCR Number' drop-down list.
- 2. Press the 'Get Report' button to retrieve any data previously entered. This report is for CR crab only, do not include crab purchased under other management programs.
- 3. After reviewing the ex-vessel volume and value data, press the 'Submit' button at the bottom of the page.
