Authority: The Homeland Security Presidential Directive (HSPD)-7 for Critical Infrastructure Identification, Prioritization, and Protection authorizes the collection of this information.

Purpose: DHS will maintain basic contact information of the Chemical Security Summit 2010 participants in order to allow for the following: communication with participants; admission into the summit; creation of name tags; and creation of a participant directory for contact purposes thereby facilitating participant communication, communication with DHS, networking, and information sharing.

Routine Uses: The information may be shared with other summit participants via an attendee list or directory. Participants must opt-in if they would like to be included in the directory.

Disclosure: Submission of the information is voluntary. However failure to provide this information may lead to the inability to be registered.

Paperwork Reduction Act Burden Notice

Paperwork Reduction Act: Using the event registration tool will significantly reduce the burden on the registrant and on Department of Homeland Security Office of Infrastructure Protection Sector-Specific Agency Executive Management Office, as the collecting agency. The registration process will take the registrant no more than six (6) minutes to complete, with an average of three (3) minutes.
