The Federal Voting Assistance Program (FVAP), in coordination with the Defense Manpower Data Center (DMDC), has selected your jurisdiction to participate in the FVAP *2010 Post-Election Voting Survey of Local Election Officials*. You will receive the paper survey in the mail around the week of November 1, 2010. The survey will also be available online around the same time.

Following each presidential election, the post-election survey is used to produce a congressional report mandated by the *Uniformed and Overseas Citizens Absentee Voting Act*.
