- Submit a signature flag for an application in a signature hold status
- Enter a FAFSA or Renewal FAFSA
- Correct a processed FAFSA
- Continue working on a saved FAFSA or Correction
- Review verification data with the Verification Tool
- Request ISIR data
- Analyze ISIR data as a basis for improving your verification process
- Calculate and manage the return of Title IV funds
