

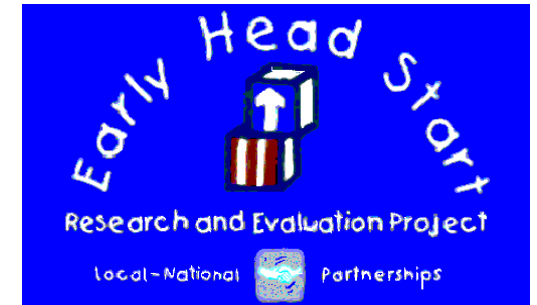
RAND is an independent non-profit research organization based in Santa Monica, California. RAND does research to help improve policy.

### ***Why are you contacting me now?***

- We hope to continue interviewing the children in this study and their caregivers. It will be important for us to reach as many families as possible. At this time we are only reaching out to you to update our records with your phone and address.

### ***What are you asking me to do?***

- You can update your contact information in one of three ways. You can mail back the form we sent you. You can call us toll free. Or you can go online and log in with your personal code that we gave you in the letter.
