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<b>Who must comply?</b>	Certified Cargo Screening Program participants; TSA Approved Validation Firms
<b>What is this collection about?</b>	This information collection requires a Certified Cargo Screening Program participant or a TSA Approved Validation Firms to submit amendments to its security program.
<b>Where do I find the requirements for this information?</b>	Title 49 CFR, Part 1549.7; Part 1522.105; 74 Fed. Reg. 47672 (September 16, 2009)
<b>When must information be submitted to the TSA?</b>	Information must be submitted to TSA before an aircraft operator, air carrier, or indirect air carrier at least 30 before the intended effective date of an amendment.
<b>How is the information submitted?</b>	Certified Cargo Screening Program participants or TSA Approved Validation Firms must submit the information to their designated official.
<b>What happens when complete information is received?</b>	Once the amendment is approved and implemented, TSA will determine compliance with the program requirements through routine onsite inspections, assessments, and tests.
<b>For additional information, contact--</b>	For additional information, Certified Cargo Screening Program participants or TSA Approved Validation Firms should contact their designated official.
