

Justification:

The I-191 Form is currently undergoing a centralization effort to process and adjudicate this application at a newly identified central location. The USCIS is therefore revising the Instructions for Form I-191 *Where to File* mail delivery information due to a change of address.

The deletion of the monetary information is due to the Office of the Chief Financial Officer providing guidance that a check made out to USDHS will be sufficient and applicants will not have to differentiate based on location.

The deletion of the London, KY address is due to the Records Management Branch ending the contract with the London, KY operating contractor. The new instructions will be revised to guide applicants to the Form AR-11 which will have the new address of where to send the form. The new address is not being placed on individual forms in order to prevent revisions to forms of this matter at a future time.
