OSC FORM 11:

No OSC Jurisdiction. OSC has no jurisdiction over complaints filed by employees of –

- the Central Intelligence Agency, Defense Intelligence Agency, National Security Agency, or other intelligence agency excluded from coverage by the President;
- the armed forces of the United States (*i.e.*, uniformed military employees);
- the General Accounting Office;
- the Postal Rate Commission; and
- the Federal Bureau of Investigation.

OSC FORM 12:

OSC JURISDICTION

The Disclosure Unit has jurisdiction over federal employees, former federal employees, and applicants for federal employment. It is important to note that a disclosure must be related to an event that occurred in connection with the performance of an employee's duties and responsibilities. The Disclosure Unit has *no jurisdiction* over disclosures filed by:

- employees of the U.S. Postal Service and the Postal Rate Commission;
- employees of the armed forces of the United States (<u>i.e.</u>, non-civilian military employees);
- employees operating under federal grants; and
- employees of federal contractors.

We are submitting the change to the words "Postal Rate Commission," which will now be "Postal Regulatory Commission"
