SUBJECT: Request Burden Hour to be Added Back into SAMHSA's Generic Customer Satisfaction Survey (OMB No. 0930-0197)

SAMHSA is requesting a change to the burden for our generic approval for "Voluntary Customer Satisfaction Surveys to Implement Executive Order 12862 in the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration."
