The Department is seeking emergency review of the Paperwork Reduction Act requirements for revised information collection which supports the Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS (HOPWA) program. The existing paperwork collection effort, identified as OMB control number 2506-0133, has an expiration date of December 31, 2010.

The Notice of Paperwork Submission (copy enclosed), proposed for immediate Federal Register publication, explains the burden of the collection requirements and invites public comments on them.

In compliance with the requirements of 5 CFR 1320.13, this letter requests emergency processing within 14 days from the date of this letter. The existing paperwork collection will expire shortly. The Department has been delayed in submitting these review documents in order to consider the potential impact of how the White House National HIV/AIDS Strategy and its proposed implementation actions may impact paperwork collection efforts for the HOPWA program.

The shortened processing period that we are requesting will enable the Department to remain compliant with existing collection requirements while providing additional preparation to solicit and consider public comment on the proposed revisions.
