Pretesting of the survey instrument is currently being conducted in four states. Lessons learned from pretesting, coupled with input from stakeholders such as yourself, will help shape a valuable product that is useful to diverse groups within the agricultural sector.

Significant changes from the 2006 survey conducted in conjunction with the Nebraska Corn Board include an expansion of states that will be surveyed and the addition of poultry as a category. Current plans are to survey livestock and poultry producers every five years as part of a new Energy Program here at NASS.
