The U.S. Department of Transportation's National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) is conducting a study of current and discontinued Automated Speed Enforcement (ASE) programs throughout the United States. M. Davis and Company, Inc. (MDAC) is collecting the data on for NHTSA and your agency has been identified as one that recently discontinued the use of ASE.

In April 2008, NHTSA published *Speed Enforcement Camera Systems Operational Guidelines*. These Guidelines were meant to provide a list of "pros" and "cons" of various communication approaches and law enforcement practices and describe how jurisdictions have implemented and conducted their ASE programs.
