**PURPOSE:**

The U.S. Fire Administration's (USFA) Conference/Symposium Form (FF 519-0-10), evaluates USFA conferences and symposia. Typically, this form is used three-four times per year; examples of its use include the following USFA programs: the Executive Fire Officer Program (EFOP) Symposium; the National Professional Development Conference, the Prevention Advocacy Resources and Data Exchange (PARADE) conference, etc. These annual data collections provide information related to what the fire and emergency services sector leaders find as useful, relevant, and job enhancing. In addition, these data collections provide a measure of the extent to which respondents feel the information gained would be important to their communities and organizations. Last, these information collections provide USFA with an index of stakeholder representation critical to improving programs and initiatives.

Respondents are individuals who are attending any one of USFA's annual conference/symposium events, e.g., the Executive Fire Officer Program Symposium; the National Professional Development Conference, the Prevention Advocacy Resources and Data Exchange Conference.
