The Department of Defense and its contractors are committed to providing equal educational opportunity.

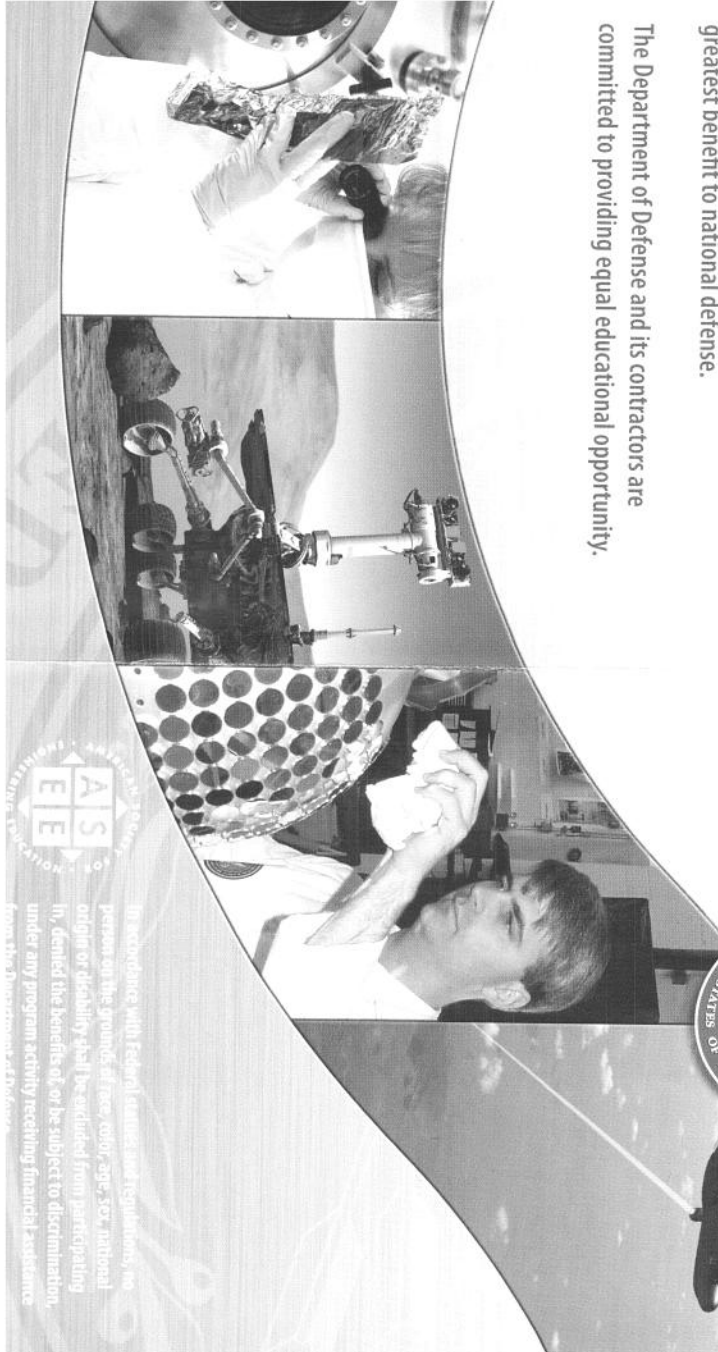
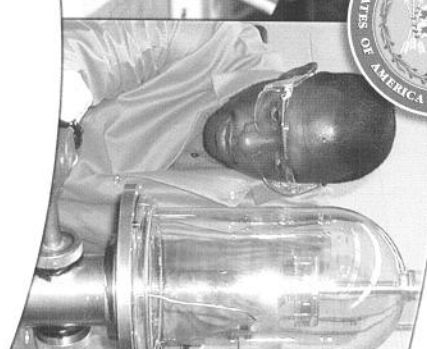
