Show the child answer sheet with icons.

Say to the child: You and I are going to spend some time talking about the National Children's Study (NCS) study; you know, the one you just saw on the video with your mom/dad. I will ask you a question about the study, and you let

me know whether you feel the answer for you is "No" (a) or "Yes" (a

in F). If you are not sure, then choose the middle one (a *in F*). Let's try a couple of practice questions so I can be sure that you understand how this works. I'll read the question and you mark the answer. (Note: Examiner can mark subsequent answers for younger children.)
