 - b. New Language: “This is only one of several steps in the process to apply online for disability benefits. If this is the first time you are learning about this process please go to **<Apply Online For Disability Benefits LINK>** to review all the steps you need to complete your application.”
2. Language in paragraph above the Myself and Someone Else Links updated.
 - a. Former Language: “**Gather the** necessary documents you need to complete the application online for:”
 - b. New Language: “**Find information and** necessary documents you need to complete the application online for:”
