The survey instrument is divided into three sections:

PART A – FOR ALL YOUTH (this section ends with a question on whether the adolescent has had sex, in which case the adolescent chooses to continue to either PART B1 or B2)

PART B1 - FOR SEXUALLY-ACTIVE YOUTH

PART B2 - FOR NON-SEXUALLY-ACTIVE YOUTH

In the following concordance instrument, "core" items are highlighted in yellow. Core items are those items that will be attempted to be collected at all federal pregnancy prevention evaluation sites, including other studies that are not PPA. Core items include proposed performance measures. The Supporting Statements, especially the introductions to each, provide further background on the core items and their relation to other instruments proposed in this package.

SUMMARY OF DIFFERENCES BETWEEN THE APPROVED PPA BASELINE QUESTIONNAIRE (OMB-APPROVED) AND THE REVISED "CONCORDANCE" BASELINE QUESTIONNAIRE

Items are listed in the order in which they appear on the baseline concordance instrument. The number for the corresponding item on the OMB-approved baseline instrument is listed in the "OMB-approved #" column. Items in Part A are listed first, followed by items in Section 4, Part B1 (for sexually active respondents), items in Section 4, Part B2 (for non-sexually active respondents) and items in Sections 5 and 6, Parts B1 and B2 (these sections are the same for sexually active and non-sexually active respondents).

- Modifications to an existing OMB-approved item are listed in the "Modifications" column; otherwise, the question text on the baseline concordance instrument is the same as that on the OMB-approved baseline instrument.
