Change in Language – passive language and terminology is changed to more direct language; unnecessary references are deleted, and requests for specific data is clarified. In order to preserve consistency, all numerals are replaced with the corresponding word.

Table of Contents – the words “Job Training” is inserted for Section 6.

General Information – The field “Tribal Agency with Fiscal Responsibility for the Grant:” is deleted. The field “Signed?” is replaced with “Telephone” under the “Authorized representative” section. The field “Signature Date:” is replaced with “E-mail” under the “Authorized representative” section. The “Note:” is revised and mailing information at the bottom of this section is deleted since grantees are required to submit an ED 524B form with original signature from the authorized representative.
