REQUEST FOR WAIVER OF THE JUNE 26, 2008 DEADLINE FOR COMPLETION OF 800 MHZ REBANDING

Pursuant to Section 1.925 (47 C.F.R. § 1.925) of the rules of the Federal Communications

Commission (Commission) and the Commission's *Public Notice*, ¹ the above-referenced licensee

("Licensee") requests a waiver of the Commission's requirement for the Licensee to complete its 800

MHz rebanding by June 26, 2008. ² The Licensee recognizes that the Commission has noted: "Requests for extension will be subject to a high level of scrutiny.
