

Introduction to Survey

As part of its work supporting the Section 337 operations of the U.S. International Trade Commission, the Office of Unfair Import Investigations (OUII) may participate in an investigation as an independent party with no commercial interest in the outcome. Since January 2011, OUII's level of participation in a given investigation has fallen into one of three categories: Full Participation on the range of issues in the investigation, Selective Participation on some issues, or No Participation on any issues.

This survey seeks feedback about OUII's level of participation in this investigation. We are asking for a single response from each participant. For parties that were represented by outside counsel, we ask that the survey be completed by the attorney who was most involved in this investigation. For parties represented by in-house counsel or a corporate representative, we ask that the survey be completed by the attorney or representative who was most involved with the investigation. This survey should take less than 15 minutes to complete.

19 U.S.C. §§ 1335 and 1337 authorize collection of this information. The survey results will be used to help the Commission decide the appropriate level of OUII participation in Section 337 investigations. Your disclosure of the information is voluntary. Your individual response will be kept confidential, and will not be publicly disclosed except as required by law.


There are a number of text boxes following individual questions. These are for any additional comments you may have and are all optional.


