 - 5. What are the LAST 2 digits of your YEAR of birth?
 - 6. Do you consider yourself to be male, female, or transgender? *(Enter recruiter's gender: M=male, F=female, T=transgender)*
 - 7. What racial/ethnic group or groups do you consider yourself to be in? (*Enter recruiter's race/ethnicity:* B= Black/African-American, H= Hispanic/Latina, W= White, A= Asian and O= Other)

INTERVIEWER INSTRUCTIONS: *Create the* **Recruiter ID** *again by asking the above questions.* For example, the recruiter ID of a Black male, last name Smith, first name Joe, mother's first name Olivia, and born in November 1961 will look like this: **SMJO1161MB**. Search the coupon database for the record with this recruiter ID.

When the recruiter's record has been located based on the recruiter ID, verify the physical marks. Once their identity has been verified, write down the person's THBS survey ID and date of their THBS interview. Then ask her the questions about how recruiting went.
