#### **Commonly Asked Questions**

#### Q: How did you get my address?

A: Your address was randomly selected from among all of the home addresses in the nation. It was selected using scientific sampling methods to represent other households in the U.S.

#### Q: Why don't you ask more questions about education in this questionnaire?

A: The purpose of this questionnaire is to find out if anyone in your household is eligible for the next stage of the survey. If so, we will send a second questionnaire that will ask about job training or educational experiences of a member of your household.

#### Q: If there are no children or anyone currently in school in my household, should I respond?

A: Yes, you should respond to this survey. Once you return the questionnaire, the study will be able to see if anyone in your household is eligible for the next and final survey. If no one is eligible, you will not receive another survey.

#### Q: Why should I take part in this study? Do I have to do this?

A: This survey is the only way that the Department of Education can learn about job training, children's care, early learning activities, and schooling from your perspective. You represent thousands of other households like yours, and you cannot be replaced. Your answers and opinions are very important to the success of this study. You may choose not to answer any or all questions in this survey. In order for the survey to be representative it is important that you complete and return this questionnaire. Those who do not return the survey will not be represented in key statistics used by policymakers and researchers.

#### Q: How will the information I provide be used? Will my privacy be protected?

A: Your responses will be combined with those of others to produce statistical summaries and reports. Your individual data will not be reported. Your answers may be used only for statistical purposes and may not be disclosed, or used, in identifiable form for any other purpose except as required by law (Section 9573, 20 US Code).

#### Q: What should I do if there are more than 10 people in my household?

A: If there are more than 10 people in your household, please call 1-888-XXX-XXXX for instructions about how to complete the form.

### Q: Should I include my son/daughter who is away at school? Should I include my mother who is visiting for the summer?

A: Include anyone who is temporarily away from home (for example, attending college or university) if they have no other permanent home. Do not include guests/visitors who have another permanent home.

#### Q: How much time will it take?

A: On average, it should take 5 minutes for you to respond, including the time for reviewing instructions and completing and reviewing the collection of information.

#### Q: Who is sponsoring the study? Is this study conducted by the Federal Government?

A: The National Center for Education Statistics, within the Department of Education, is authorized to conduct this study (Section 9543, 20 US Code). The U.S. Census Bureau is conducting this study on behalf of the U.S. Department of Education. 
