The Online Application for Passport Card (OAPC) is a web application system that allows qualified U.S. citizens to apply for a passport card online. OAPC allows the applicant to complete the form, pay applicable fees, upload a passport photo, and submit the application package online. The U.S. Passport Card is a wallet-size travel document that can be used to enter the United States from Canada, Mexico, the Caribbean, and Bermuda at land border crossings or sea ports-of-entry. The passport card cannot be used for international travel by air. NOTE: This document contains screen captures of OAPC. It does not include screenshots of web pages from other sites (i.e. Pay.gov, TSG). The screenshots contained in this document are presented according to sequence as they appear in OAPC.




Figure 1-2: OAPC Footer




Figure 3-1: Notices and Disclaimers




Figure 3-2: Paper Reduction Statement




Figure 4-1: Getting Started

- 5. The emergency contact name on your most recent passport application AND
- The complete permanent address with zip code on your most recent passport application.

If you do not meet these criteria, you may still apply for a U.S. passport card using other methods. Please read the U.S. Passport Card information page.




Figure 4-3: Determine Eligibility (Collapsed)




Figure 4-8: Determine Eligibility (Expanded) – Question 7




Figure 4-12: Personal Information – cont'd




Figure 4-13: Federal Tax Law




Figure 4-16: Emergency Contact Information




Figure 4-17: Emergency Contact Information – cont'd




Figure 4-18: Travel Plans Information




Figure 5-1: Confirm Photo




Figure 5-3: IQOTW Upload Photo




Figure 6-4: Confirm and Sign




Figure 6-6: Privacy Act Statement in Notices and Warnings pop-up window

In accordance with the Debt Collection Improvement Act (Pub.L. 104-134), if the fees remain unpaid after 180 days and no repayment arrangements have been made, the Department will refer the debt to the Department of Treasury for collection. Debt collection procedures used by Treasury may include referral of the debt to private collection agencies, reporting of the debt to credit bureaus, garnishment of private wages and administrative offset of the debt by reducing or withholding eligible federal payments (e.g. tax refunds, social security payments, federal retirement, etc.) by the amount of your debt, including any interest penalties or other costs incurred. ELECTRONIC PASSPORT STATEMENT

The Department of State now issues a type of passport book containing an embedded electronic chip and called an "Electronic Passport". The electronic passport book continues to be proof of the bearer's United States citizenship/nationality and identity, and looks and functions in the same way as a passport without a chip. The addition of an electronic chip in the back cover enables the passport book to carry a duplicate electronic copy of all information from the data page. The electronic passport book is usable at all ports-of-entry, including those that do not yet have electronic chip readers.

Use of the electronic format provides the traveler the additional security protections inherent in chip technology. Moreover, when used at ports-of- entry equipped with electronic chip readers, the electronic passport book provides for faster clearance through some of the port-of-entry processes.

The electronic passport book does not require special handling or treatment, but like previous versions should be protected from extreme heat, bending, and from immersion in water. The electronic chip must be read using specially formatted readers, which protects the data on the chip from unauthorized reading.

The cover of the electronic passport book is printed with a special symbol representing the embedded chip. The symbol will appear in port-of-entry areas where the electronic passport book can be read.




Figure 6-12: See Example link




Figure 8-1: Confirmation – Application Submitted




Figure 9-1: OAPC Email Confirmation
