## Major Changes to Form 730 (Rev. January 2009)

1. The term "Optional" in the Paid Preparer's Use Only section was deleted. A paid preparer is now required to sign the tax form. (PL 110-28, sec. 8246)

2. A sentence was added to the jurat in the signature block since paid preparer's are required to sign the tax form.
(PL 110-28. sec. 8246)

3. On page 3, column 2, in the section under "What is not taxed", slot machines and video games were added under coin-operated devices.
