## A. Justification

1. Administrative requirements. The Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR) specifies that agencies shall prepare an evaluation of contractor performance for each contract in excess of \$100,000, at the time the work under the contract is completed.

The solicitation shall also authorize offerors to provide information on problems encountered on the identified contracts and the offeror's corrective actions. The Government shall consider this information, as well as information obtained from any other sources, when evaluating the offeror's past performance as part of the source selection process.

The content and format of performance evaluation is established in accordance with agency procedures and should be tailored to the size, content, and complexity of the contractual requirements.

- 2. **Uses of information**. The information is used to support future award decisions.
- 3. Consideration of information technology. We use improved information technology to the maximum extent practicable. Where both the Government agency and the offeror are capable of electronic interchange, the offerors may submit this information collection requirement electronically.
- 4. **Efforts to identify duplication**. This requirement is issued under the Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR), which has been developed to standardize Federal procurement practices and eliminate unnecessary duplication.

- 5. If the collection of information impacts small businesses or other entities, describe methods used to minimize burden. The burden applied to small businesses is the minimum consistent with applicable laws, Executive orders, regulations, and prudent business practices.
- 6. Describe consequence to Federal program or policy activities if the collection is not conducted or is conducted less frequently. Collection of information on a basis other than solicitation-by-solicitation is not practical.
