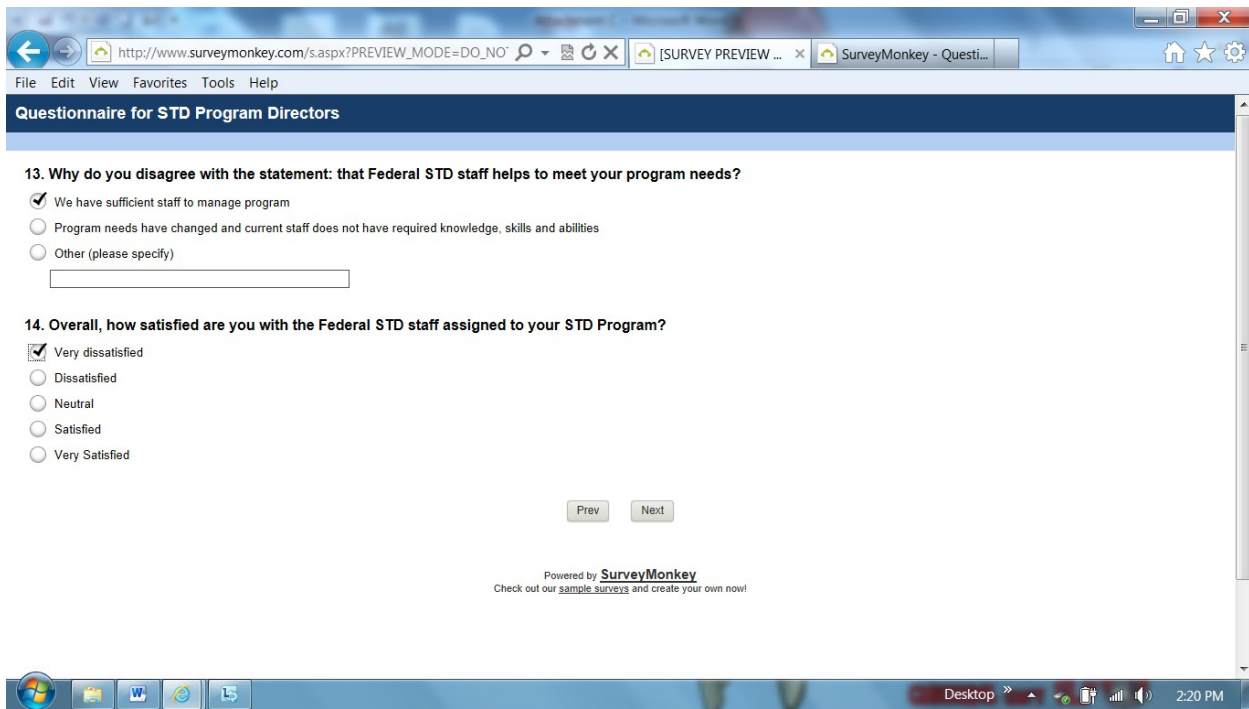

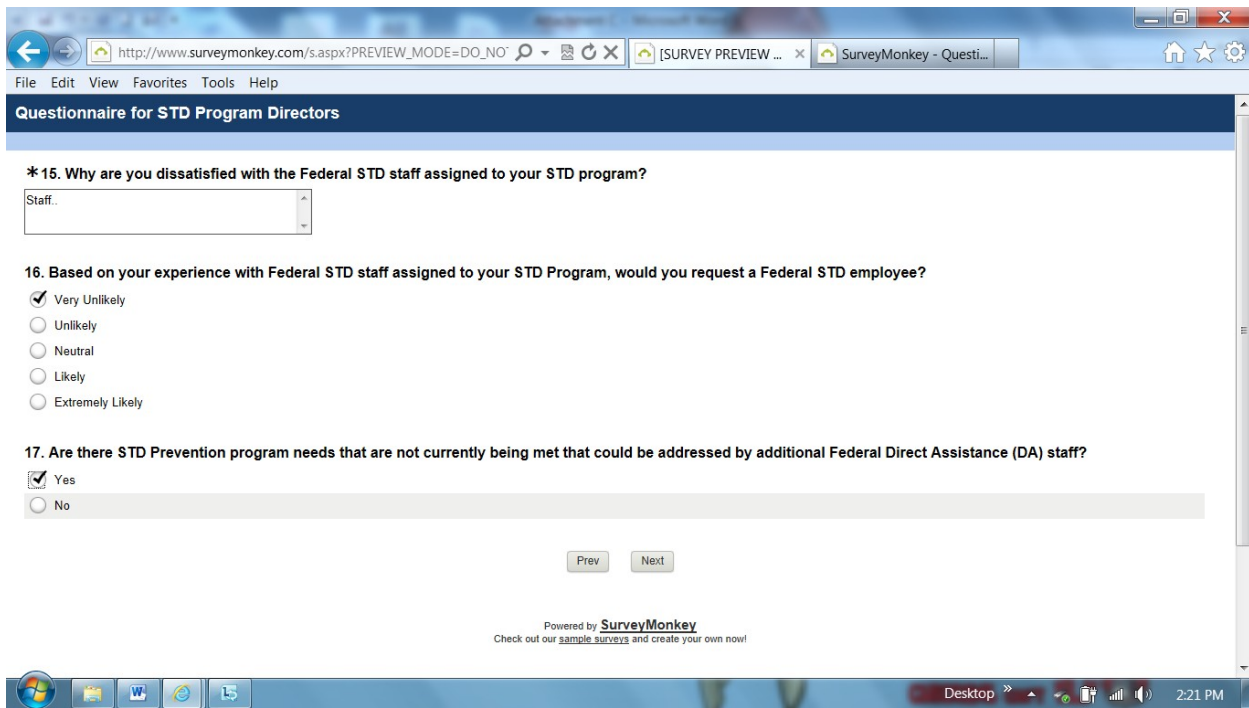

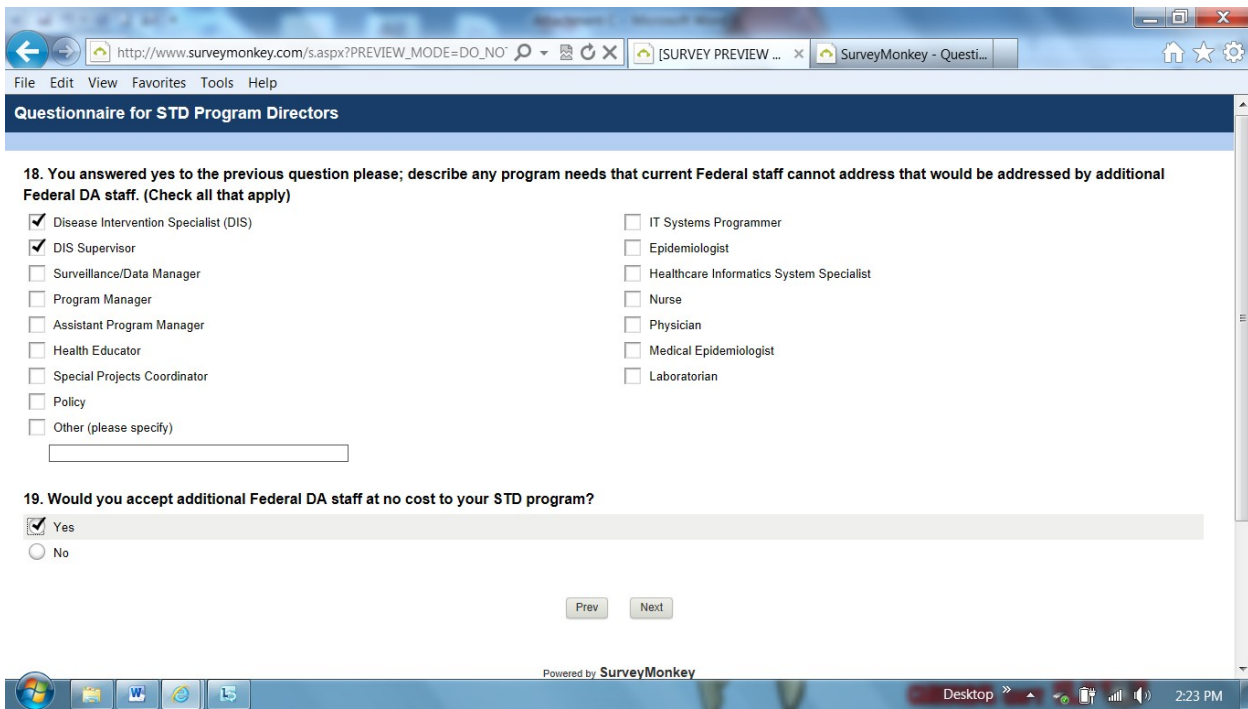

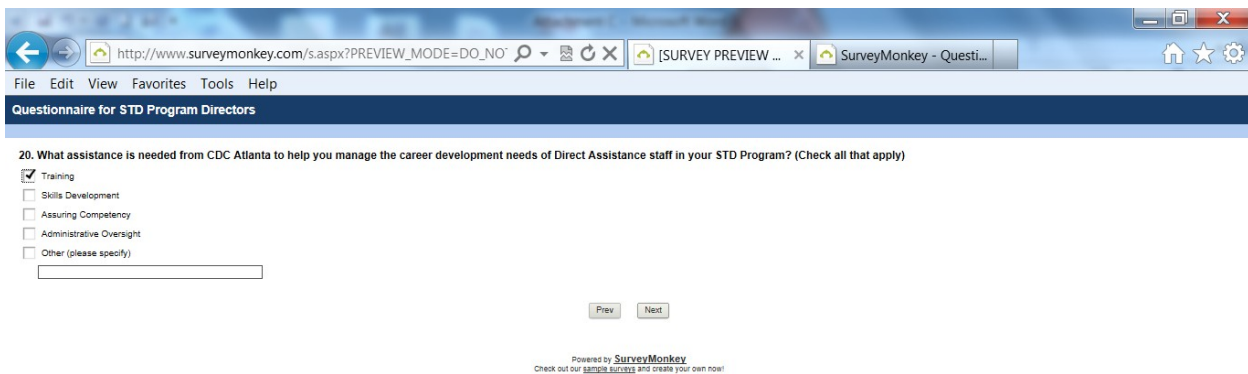

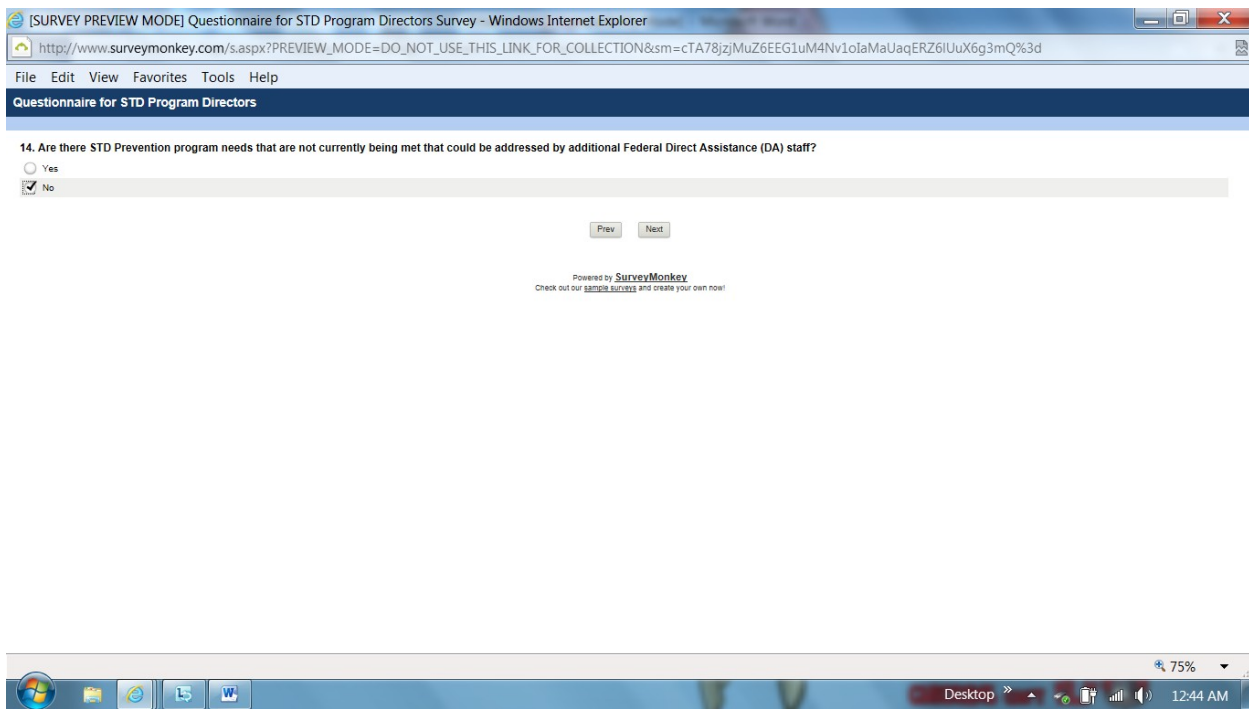

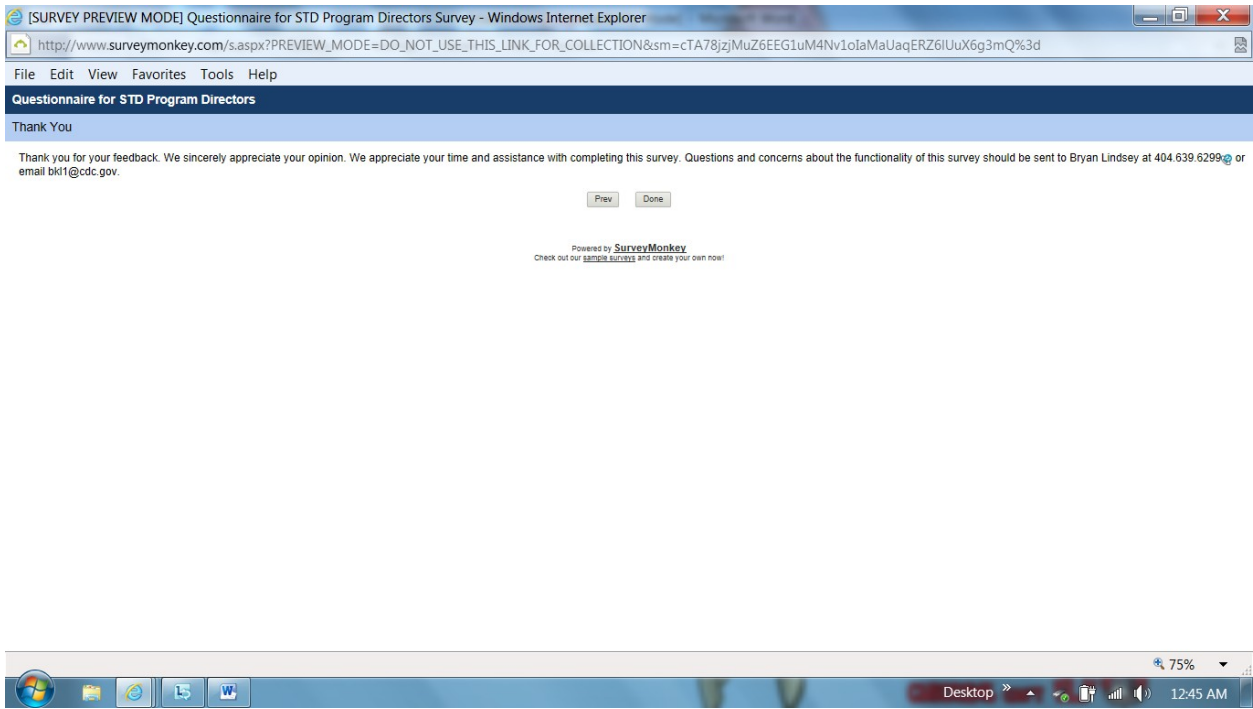

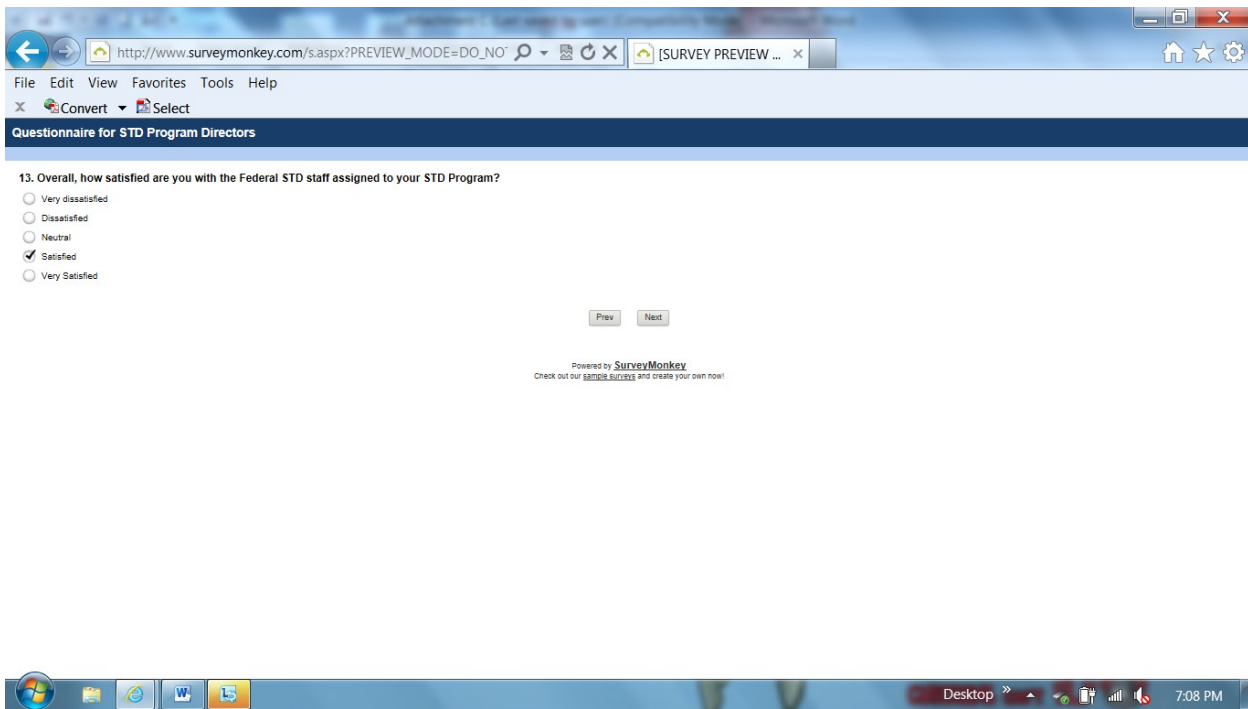

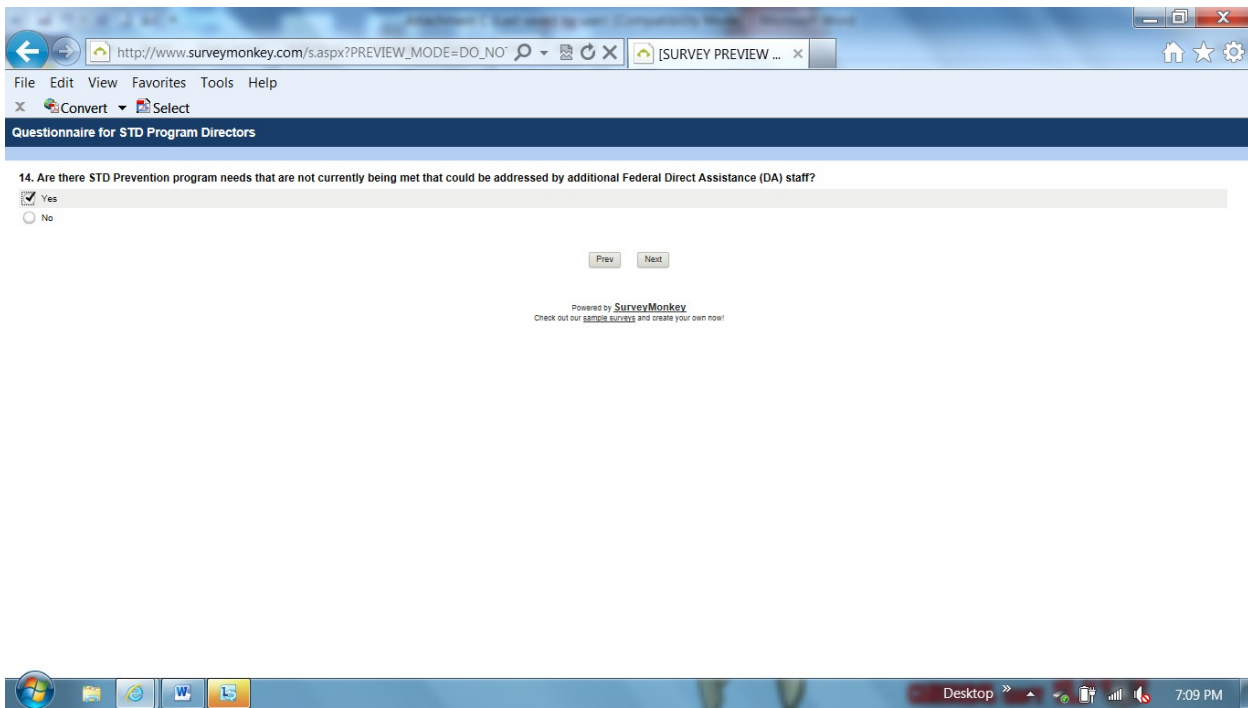

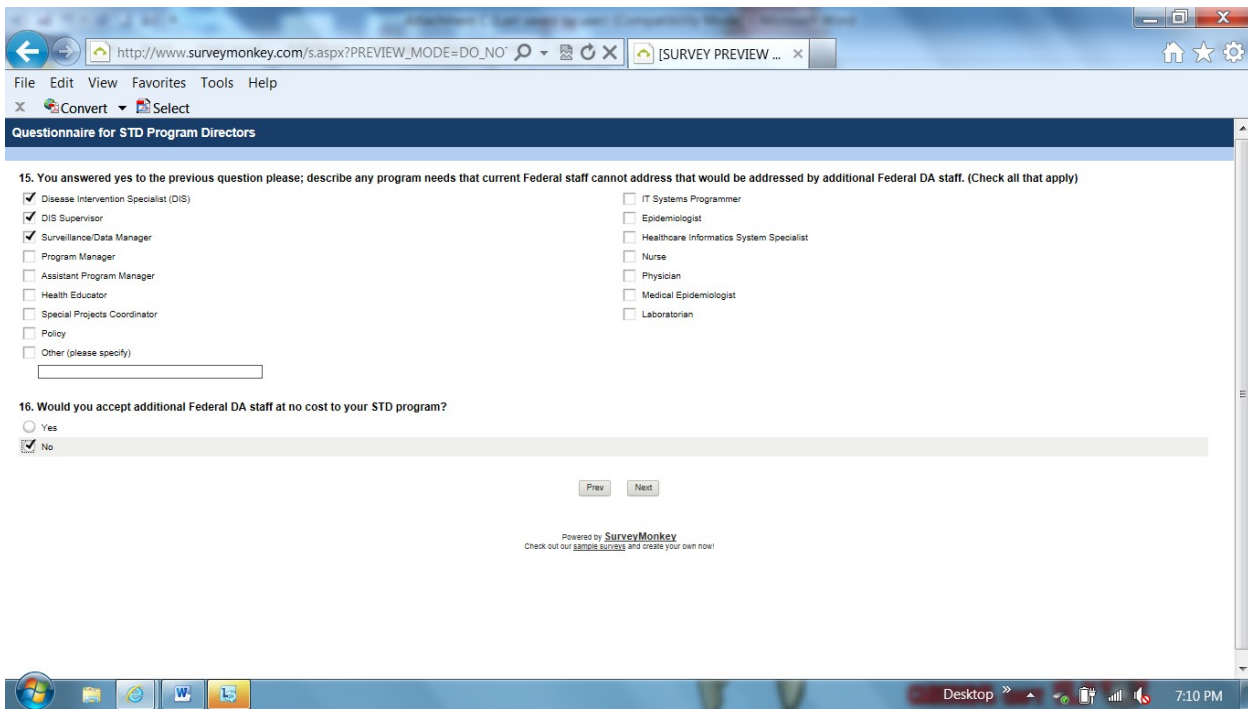

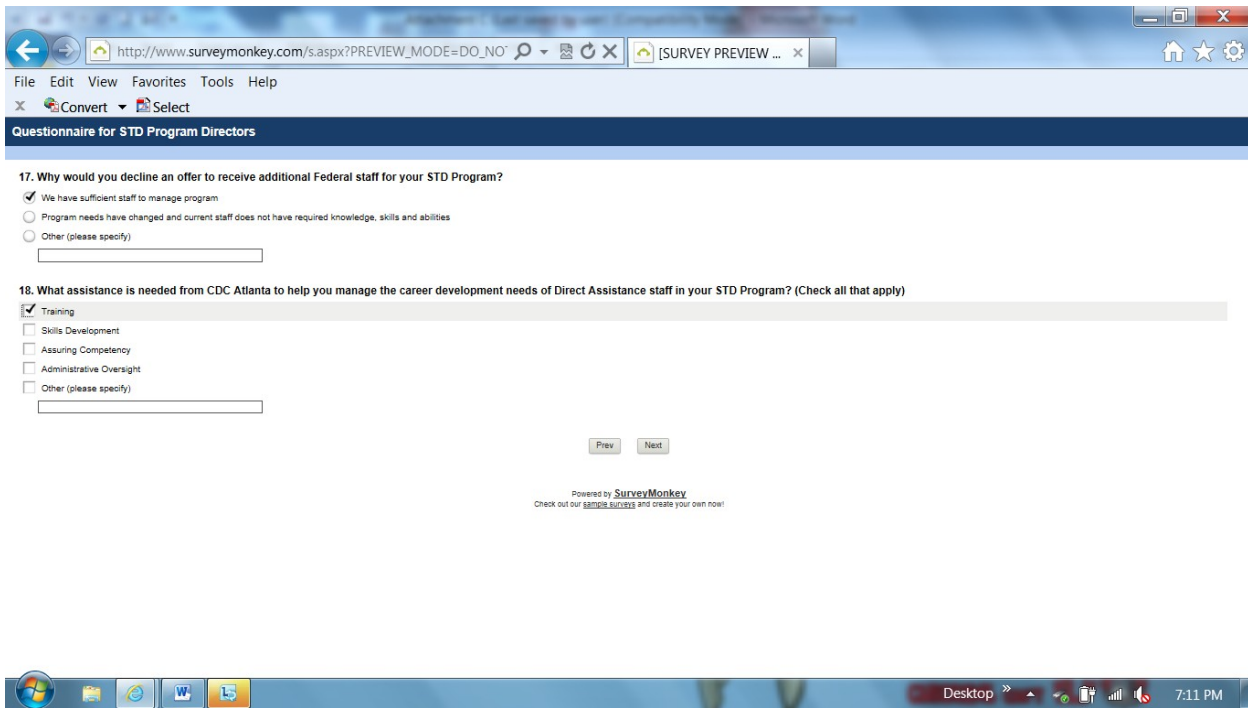

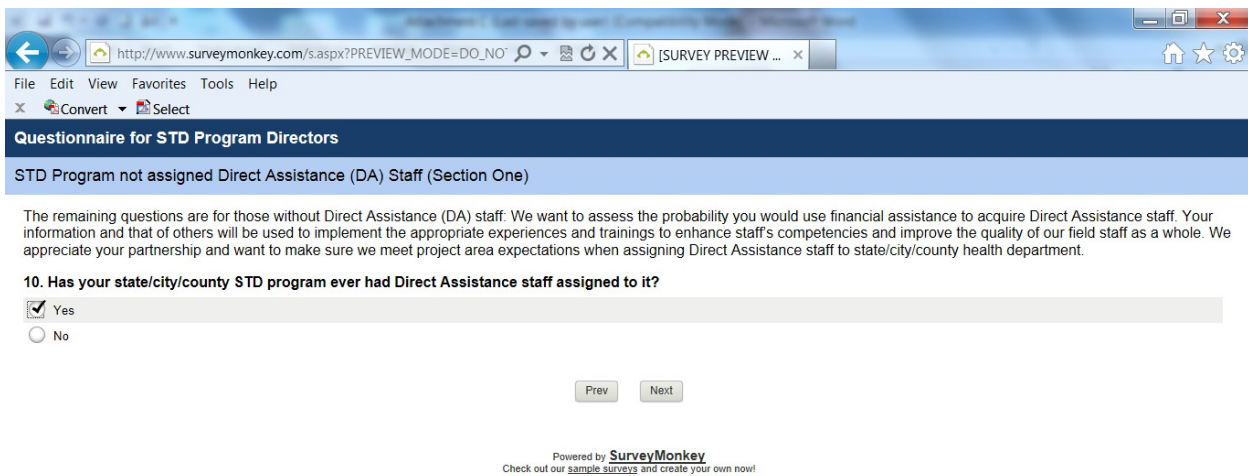

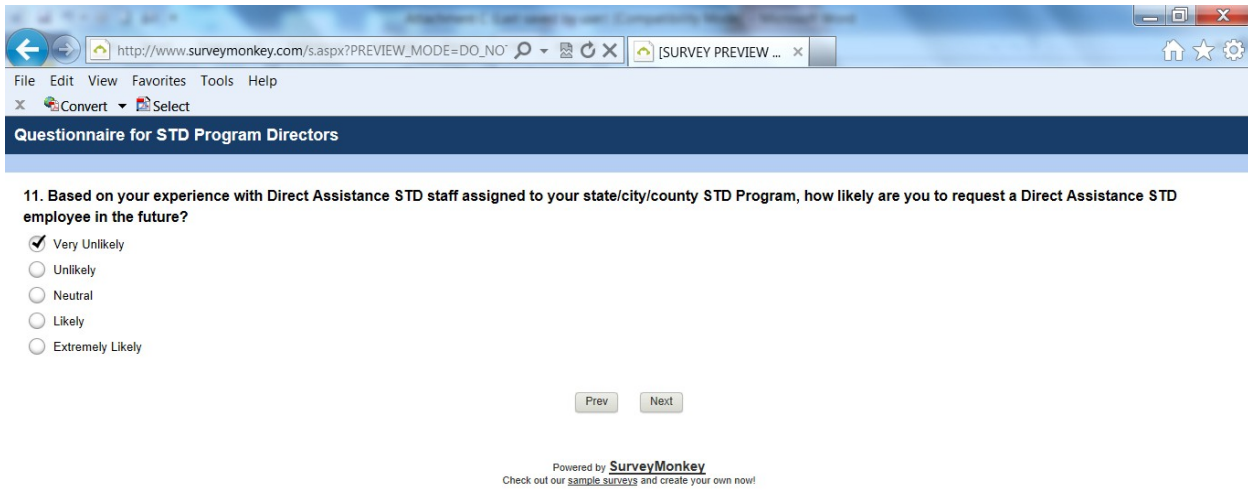

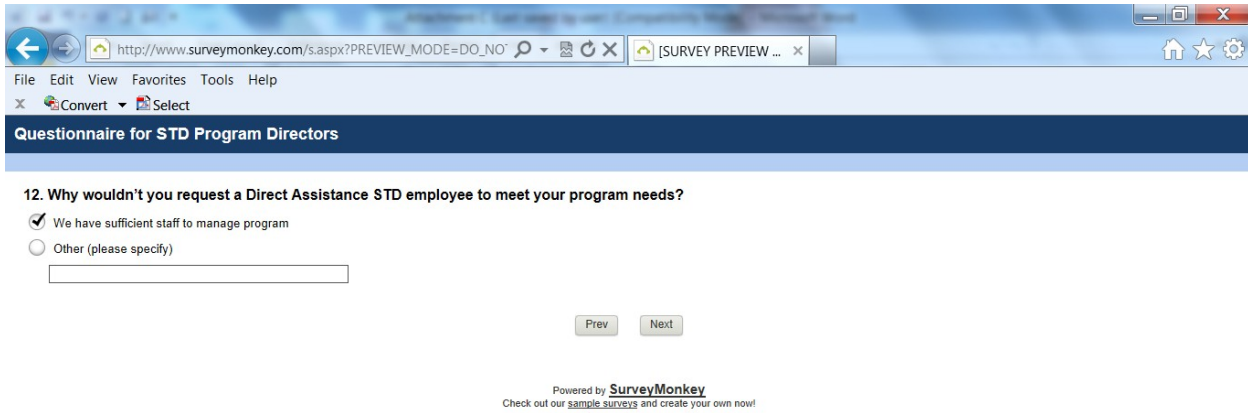
Q9: Skip pattern if No go to question “Has your state/city/county STD program ever had Direct Assistance staff assigned to it?”

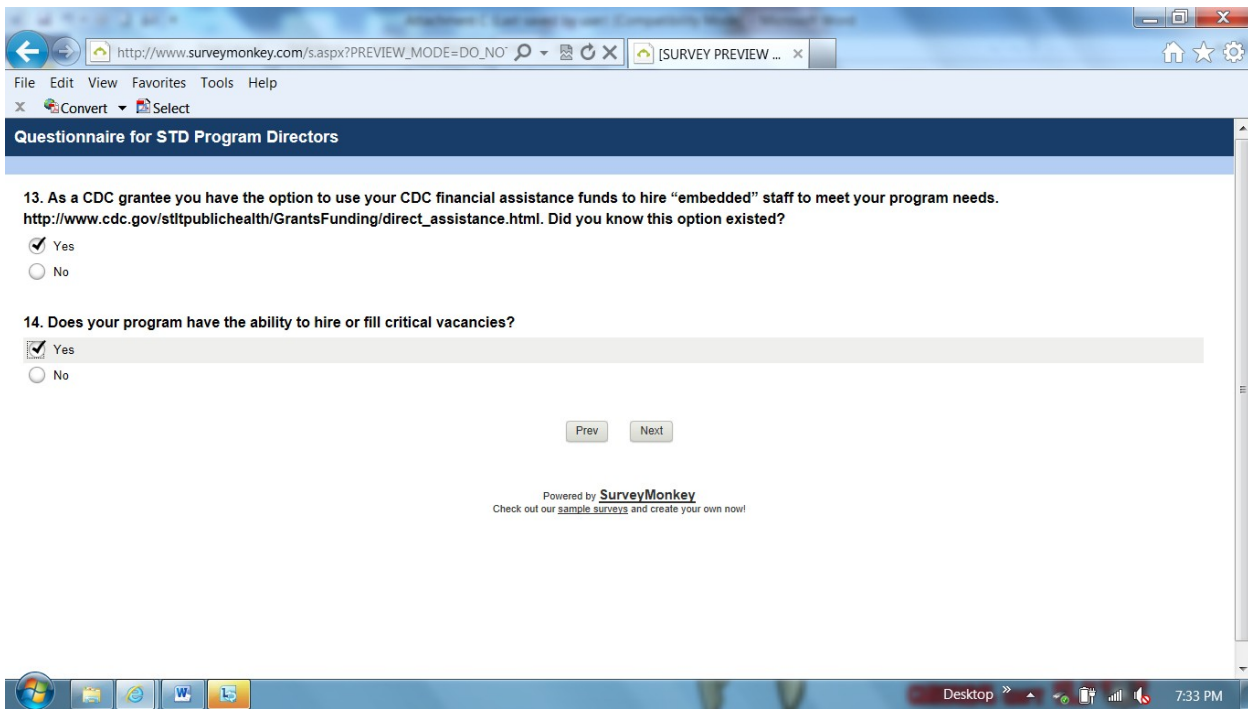

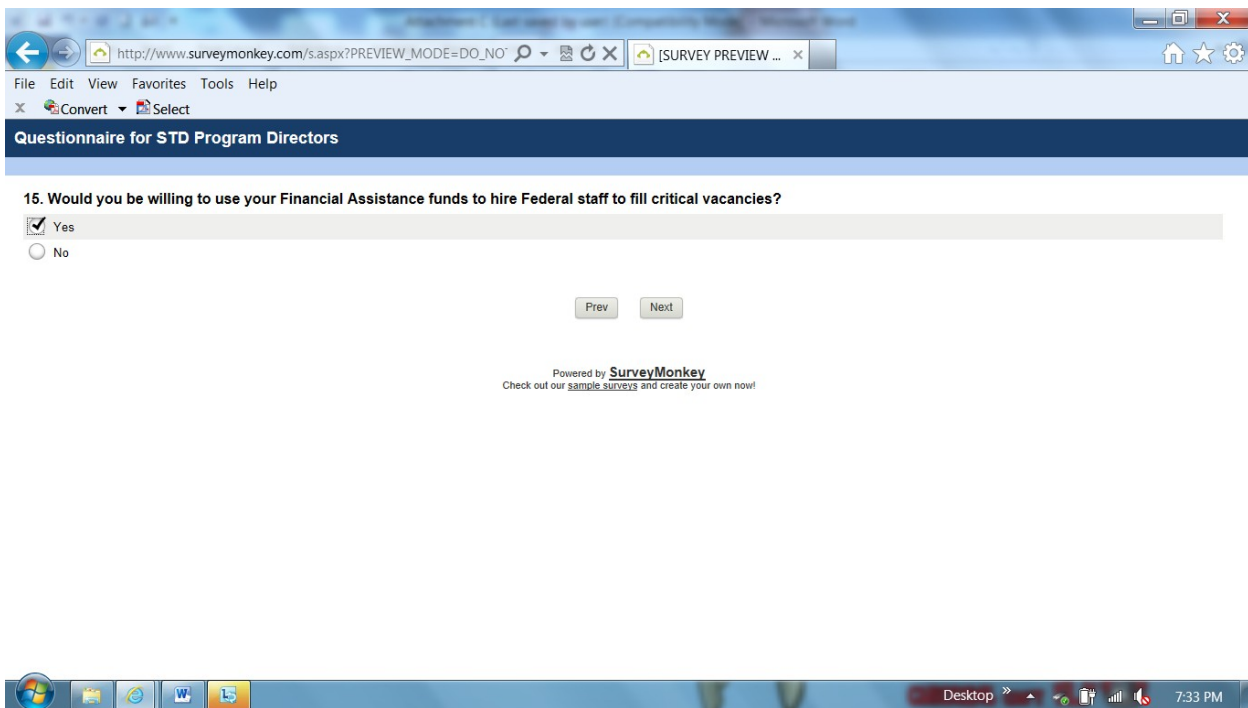


Q11: Skip pattern if Very Unlikely or Unlikely go to question “Why wouldn’t you request a Direct Assistance STD employee to meet your program needs?”

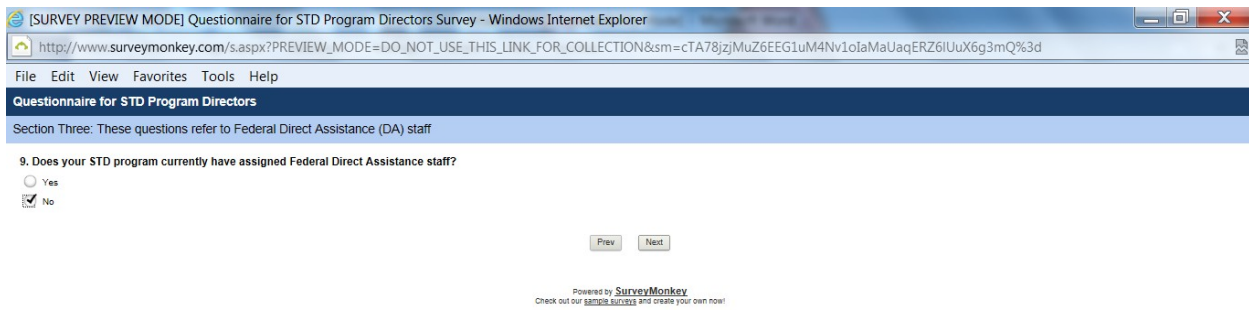

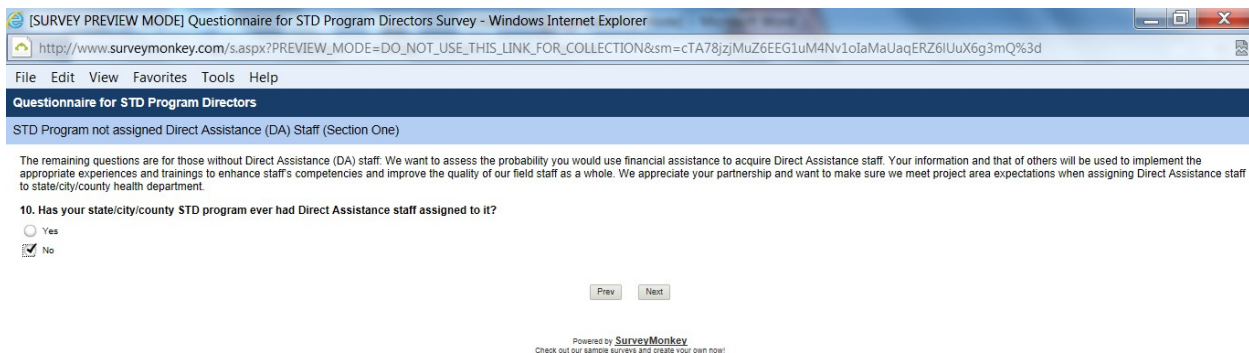

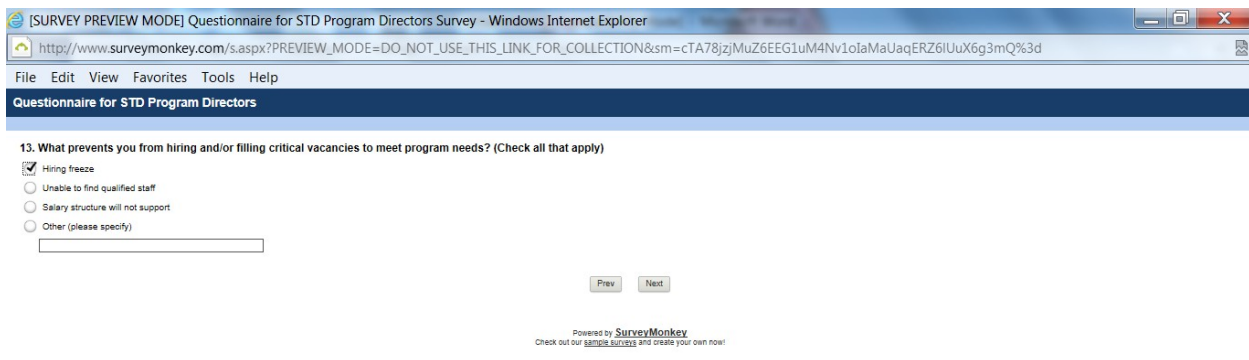
Q9: Skip pattern if No go to question “Has your state/city/county STD program ever had Direct Assistance staff assigned to it?”

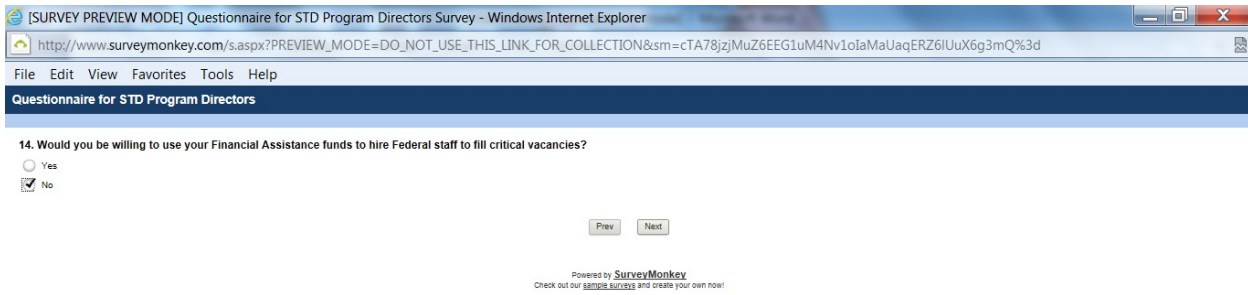

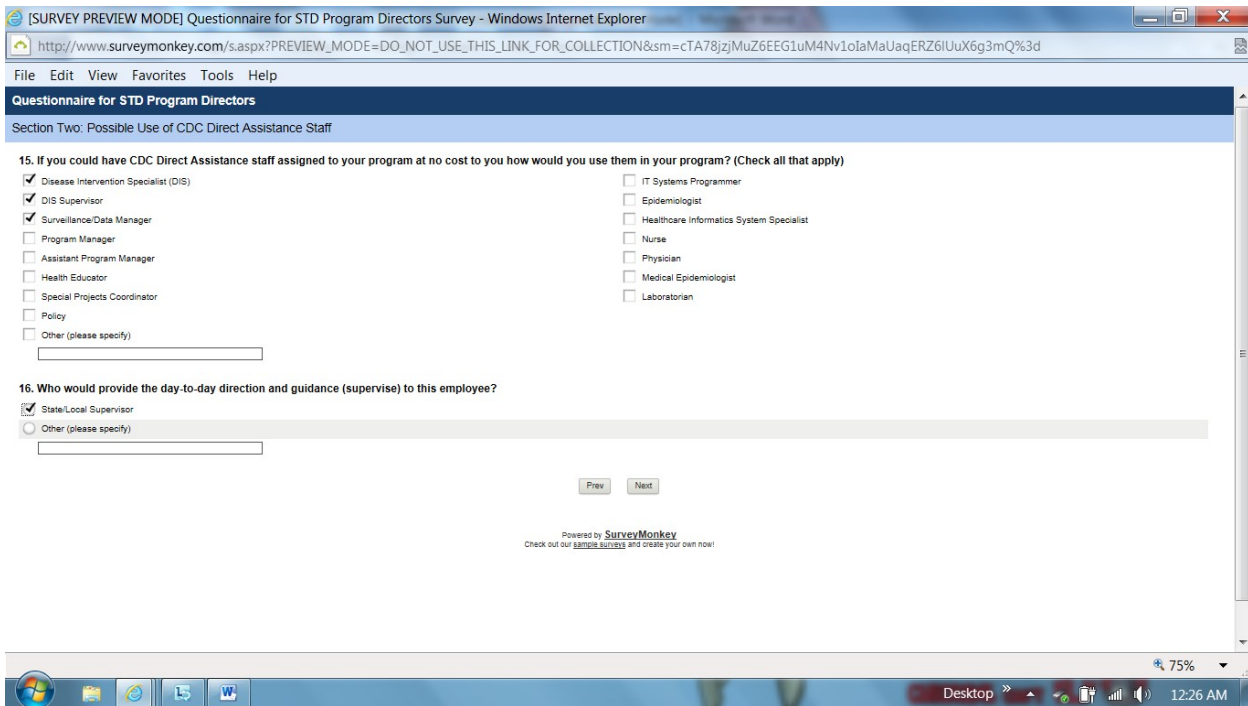


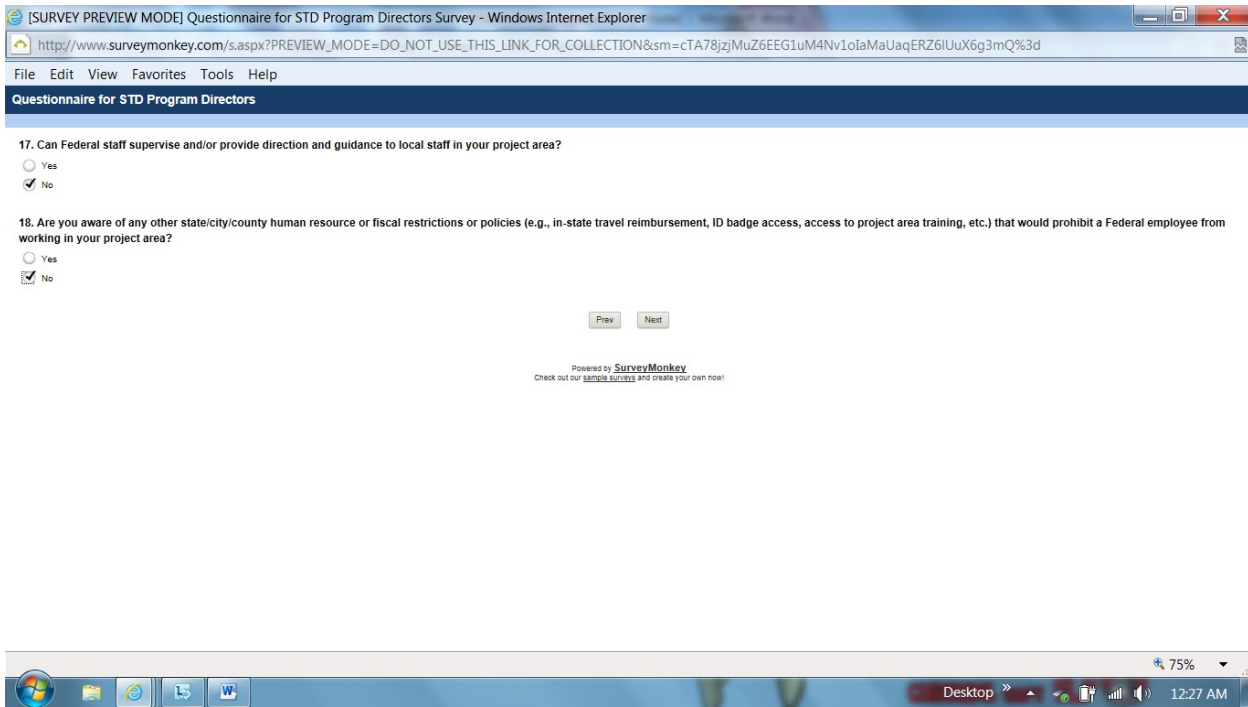
