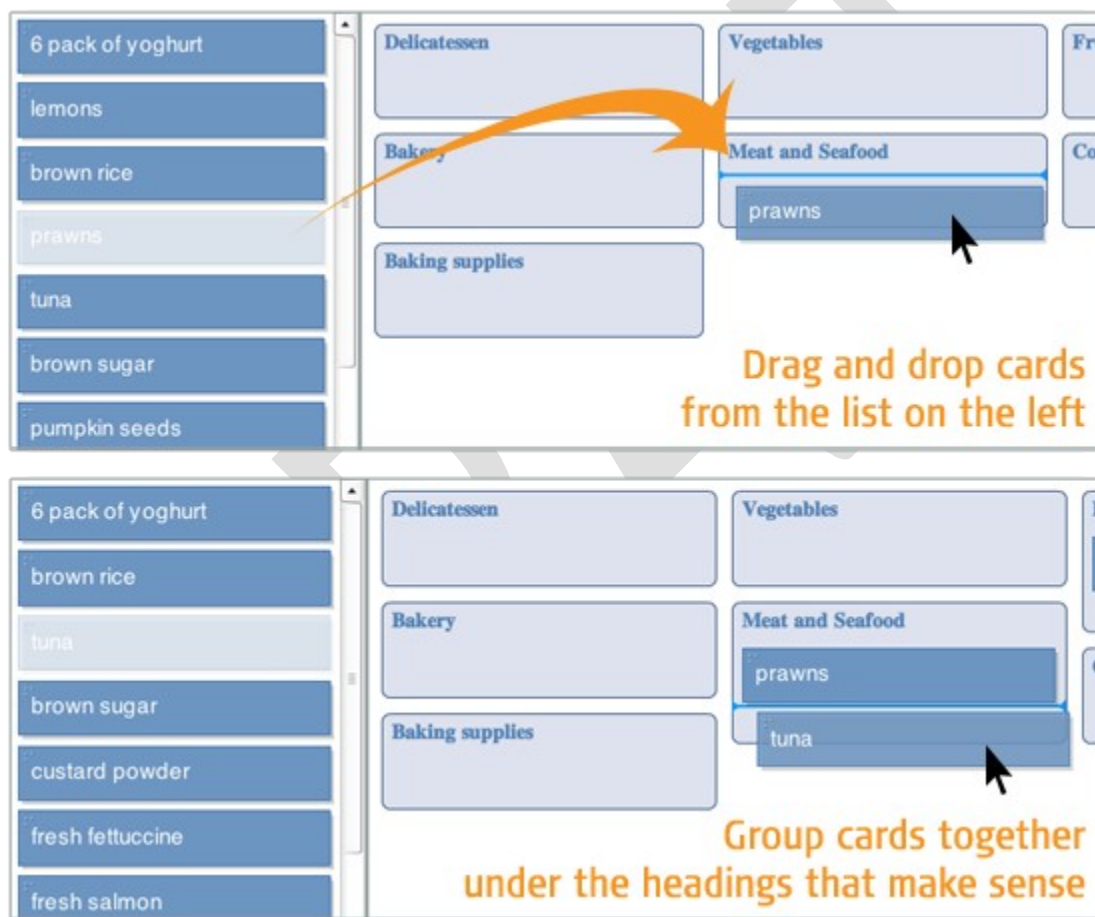
## #2) INSTRUCTIONS
