Column 4. Physical inventory adjustment only. Report adjustments necessary to correct ending inventory shown for the preceding report period. If adjustment is significant, explain undeer Remarks. Show negative figures in parentheses.

Column 5. Beginning stocks. Report all cadmium metals and compounds (COLUMN 1) on hand at this establishment at the beginning of the report period, regardless of ownership.
