The Total Volume Compliance Report must be submitted annually. In the case of Truck Loading Terminals (the point where D&T ends), this report must be submitted quarterly. Submit this report separately for each facility, each designation of fuel, and tax/dye/marker status, that a facility had custody of during the compliance period. In the fourth quarter, both a quarterly (4th quarter) and annual report must be submitted by the Truck Terminal.

Reports using this form must be submitted quarterly in the case of Truck Loading Terminals with due dates of November 30th, February 28th, May 31st, and August 31st. Annual reports using this form must be submitted by August 31st.
