Last year, your school participated in the Schools and Staffing Survey (SASS), sponsored by the National Center for Education Statistics (NCES). I would like to thank you and your staff for your cooperation. By sharing information about your professional lives and your school, you have helped to create reliable, nationally representative data on our nation's schools and educators.

One policy question that cannot be addressed with the SASS data is what proportion of teachers leave classroom teaching from public or private schools. To address this question, it is important to obtain measures of teacher attrition and retention.
