NOTES TO RECRUITER:

Composition of each of two groups:

- Group 1: Community Service Delivery Organizations working with Hispanic recently arrived immigrants (5 years or less in U.S.)
- Group 2: Community Service Delivery Organizations working with Hispanic/Latino acculturated participants (more than 5 years in U.S.)

For each group, recruit 12 participants anticipating that 9 will attend. Attempt to recruit community service delivery organizations from a variety of the following sectors:

- Non-profit
- Business
- Community Clinics/Hospitals/Churches/Religious Organization
- Traffic Safety
