Parts 94, 95, or 96 and as directed by an inspector of the United States Department of Agriculture.							
2. Restricted imports must go forward from the port of arrival to the approved establishment I closed transportation vehicles which are capable of being sealed, except when							
packed in tight containers acceptable to a Department Inspector, such shipments may go forward with other fright and without sealing.
