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<b>Who must comply?</b>	Certified Cargo Screening Program participants; TSA Approved Validation Firms
<b>What is this collection about?</b>	This information collection requires a Certified Cargo Screening Program participant or a TSA Approved Validation Firm to maintain records demonstrating compliance with all statutes, regulations, directives, orders, and security programs that apply to the operations of a Certified Cargo Screening Program participant or a TSA Approved Validation Firm.
<b>Where do I find the requirements for this information?</b>	Title 49 CFR, Part 1549.105(a); Part 1522.129; 74 Fed. Reg. 47672 (September 16, 2009); Order for the Certified Cargo Screening Program; Validation Firm Standard Security Program.
<b>When must information be submitted to the TSA?</b>	Information must be submitted to TSA upon request or during a review of compliance with the program requirements through routine onsite inspections, assessments, and tests.
<b>How is the information submitted?</b>	The information must be submitted in accordance with the regulations. CCSP Participants or TSA Approved Validation Firms may submit information, to a TSA representative during a review of compliance or these entities may submit the information to a TSA representative by way of e-mail at <a href="mailto:CCSP@dhs.gov">CCSP@dhs.gov</a> or via fax at (703) 603-0725.
<b>What happens when complete information is received?</b>	TSA will determine compliance with the program requirements through routine onsite inspections, assessments, and tests by examining the records submitted by the CCSP Participant or TSA Approved Validation Firm.
