Dear Chief:

In the fall of 2001, the U. S. Fire Administration (USFA) initiated a National Fire Department Census. To date, over 26,000 fire departments have registered with the census. It is estimated that there are more than 30,000 fire departments in the United States.

The purpose of the census is to get an accurate picture of the Nation's fire service. Basic identifying information provided by your department will be shared through the USFA web site, and the registered departments will serve as a pool from which future studies may be conducted.
