Instructions for reporting

- 1. Report pounds of fresh fruit received on a pay-weight basis. The term "pay weight" refers to the quantity of fruit delivered and paid for. Culls considered to be of no value should not be included in the quantity received.
- 2. Report total dollars or final price paid at the processing plant door on a pay-weight basis, not gross weight. Include the cost of the following materials and services furnished to growers without charge or the cost in excess of charges to growers for: land preparation; planting and cultivation; plants; weed, insect or disease control; harvesting; delivery to processing plant; containers; inspection and grading fees. EXCLUDE buying expenses, brokerage fees, and cost of fieldsmen.
- 3. <u>Report by cooperatives.</u> If all payments have not been made to growers, please give your estimate of final price paid including the costs listed in Item 2 above, and then label it as "NF," not final. Do not include dividends paid to growers that are based on capital stock ownership.
