

improving the quality of health care





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What Parts of My Health Care Information Might Be Electronically Accessible?

- Diagnosis
- Health history
- Laboratory tests
- Radiology reports and images
- Medication history
- May include Sensitive Personal Health Information such as:
 - Alcohol or drug abuse problems
 - Genetic diseases or tests
 - HIV/AIDS



- Mental health conditions
- Birth control and abortion
- Sexually transmitted infections



Legal Considerations

 Storing, transmitting and accessing patient Health Care Information is subject to specific requirements and guidelines:





Regulations



Policies



... at the Federal, State, and Local levels

Consent is a very complex topic!



Who Might Have Access to My Health Care Information?

- Health Care Providers, Health Insurance Payer Case Managers, and Health Insurance Payer Disease Management Nurses may access your information:
 - IF you have given permission and they are <u>directly</u> involved in your care,

OR

In the event of a medical emergency, unless you have specifically denied medical emergency access.

Important Note: The only Health Care Payer personnel that can see your Health Care Information through HEALTHeLINK are <u>Case</u> <u>Managers and Disease Management Nurses.</u>

What are My Health Care Information Sharing Consent Options?

- Yes: I give consent for all Participants who are involved in my care to access <u>ALL</u> of my electronic health information through HEALTHELINK.
- Yes/Except: I give consent for all Participants who are involved in my care to access ALL of my electronic health information through HEALTHeLINK <u>EXCEPT</u> the following Participants (Participants Name/Address to be listed by patient).
- No/Except: I deny consent for all Participants who are involved in my care to access my electronic health information through HEALTHELINK for any purpose, <u>EXCEPT</u> in a medical emergency.
- No/Never: I deny consent for all Participants who are involved in my care to access my electronic health information through HEALTHeLINK for any purpose
